I truly believe that parents are the first teachers God gives us. They are the ones who teach us the first lessons of life and guide our first steps.

In India, Teachers' Day is celebrated every year on 5 September, commemorating the birth anniversary of Dr. Sarvepalli Radhakrishnan, the second President of India, who greatly valued teachers and recognised their vital role in shaping the minds of future generations.



I wonder how many of us still remember our School Teachers, Sunday School Teachers, and Bible College Lecturers. Most importantly, do we remember our primary school teachers who taught us how to hold a pencil, write our first letters, and count our first numbers?

As time passes, we often forget the ladder by which we climbed to where we are today.

My mother, Mrs. Jeyaseeli Selvan, was a primary school teacher for 32 years. She taught all the academic subjects to generations of children in our area.

She was also our Sunday School teacher who introduced us to our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ.

She was not merely an educator; she was an instrument through whom many children were introduced to Lord Jesus Christ at a young age, both in their secular education and spiritual lives.

She was also the first Sunday School teacher in our **Echo of His Call** Main Church, through whom many of our present church leaders and assistant pastors were nurtured and raised.

I thank God for her life and remember with gratitude her unwavering faith in our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ.

**Remember to remember!**

The Bible repeatedly teaches us to remember.

Remember the Lord, who has done great things for us.

Forgetfulness is not always a simple failure of memory. The Bible presents it as something much more serious. Being grateful is extremely important, because one of the quietest yet most dangerous sins mentioned in Scripture is the sin of forgetfulness.

We often think of sin as something obvious - rebellion, anger, dishonesty, immorality, or pride. But the Bible also warns us about a more subtle condition of the heart: forgetting God and forgetting His goodness.

**God's Word warns and reminds us**

❖ Deuteronomy 6:12: **Be careful that you do not forget the LORD...**

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❖ Deuteronomy 8:2: **Remember how the LORD your God led you all the way in the desert these forty years ...**

❖ Psalm 103:2: **Praise the LORD, O my soul; and forget not all His benefits.**

❖ 1 Chronicles 16:12: **Remember the wonders He has done, His miracles, and the judgments He pronounced.**

❖ Psalm 77:11-12: **I will remember the deeds of the LORD; yes, I will remember Your miracles of long ago. I will meditate on all Your works and consider all Your mighty deeds.**

Forgetfulness in the Bible is not simply a failure of memory; it can be a failure of gratitude.

It is when a person enjoys the blessing but ignores the Source of the blessing. It is when someone receives kindness but fails to acknowledge the kindness shown to them. It is when people celebrate where they are today while forgetting the sacrifices, prayers, and faithfulness of those who helped them get there.

Throughout the Bible, we find people who were blessed through the goodness of others, yet failed to remember. Their stories are not recorded merely to criticise them; they are written as warnings for us.

The question we must ask ourselves is:

Have we ever enjoyed God's blessings while forgetting the people God used to bless us?

## 1. FORGOTTEN FAVOUR: JOSEPH AND THE CUPBEARER! Genesis 40-41!

Joseph's journey was filled with rejection and disappointment.

His own brothers betrayed him, sold him into slavery, and separated him from the comfort of his family. Yet even in Egypt, God remained with Joseph.

After being falsely accused by Potiphar's wife, Joseph was thrown into prison. Even there, God gave him favour and used his gift of interpreting dreams.

One day, Pharaoh's cupbearer and baker were imprisoned with Joseph. Both had troubling dreams, and Joseph, through God-given wisdom, interpreted them. The interpretation came to pass, and the cupbearer was restored to his position in Pharaoh's palace.

As the cupbearer prepared to leave, Joseph made a simple request:

**... Remember me when it is well with you, and please show kindness to me ...** Genesis 40:14.

Joseph did not ask for a reward. He simply asked to be remembered.

**But the Bible records a painful reality:**

**Yet the chief butler did not remember Joseph, but forgot him.** Genesis 40:23.

The cupbearer returned to comfort while Joseph remained in prison. The man who had received hope forgot the man through whom God had given him hope.

Sometimes people forget the kindness shown to them because they become consumed with their own blessings. The cupbearer was no longer in prison, and perhaps the pain of his past quickly faded. His freedom became more important to him than Joseph's suffering.

But human forgetfulness never cancels God's faithfulness.

For two more years, Joseph remained forgotten by man, but he was never forgotten by God. Amen!

At the appointed time, God opened a door that no human could close. Joseph moved from prison to the palace in a single day.

Dear brothers and sisters, this story reminds us that we should not measure our worth by whether people remember us or recognise what we have done. Our reward does not come only from human recognition. God sees every act of kindness, every sacrifice, and every moment of faithfulness.

**Be encouraged:**

**... Your Father who sees in secret will (Himself) reward you openly.**  
- Matthew 6:6.

**But this story also challenges us:**

- ❖ Who has helped us along the way whom we have forgotten?
- ❖ Who prayed for us when we were struggling?
- ❖ Who encouraged us when we wanted to give up?

May we never become people who remember our blessings but forget those who helped carry our burdens.

## 2. FORGOTTEN FATHER: JOASH AND JEHOIADA! 2 Chronicles 24!

The story of King Joash is one of the saddest examples of forgotten faithfulness.

Joash became king of Judah when he was only seven years old. His survival was a miracle. When his grandmother Athaliah attempted to destroy the royal family, Joash was rescued and hidden in the temple.

The man who protected him was Jehoiada the priest.

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Jehoiada did more than save Joash's life. He guided him, taught him God's ways, and helped restore true worship in Judah. Under Jehoiada's leadership, Joash did what was right in the sight of the Lord.

For many years, Joash benefited from the wisdom and spiritual guidance of this faithful servant of God. But after Jehoiada died, everything changed.

Joash listened to ungodly advisers and turned away from the Lord. He abandoned the God whom Jehoiada had taught him to follow.

**The Bible says:**

**Joash the king did not remember the kindness which Jehoiada had shown him (2 Chronicles 24:22).**

- ❖ The man who saved his life was forgotten.
- ❖ The mentor who guided him was forgotten.
- ❖ The spiritual father who invested in him was forgotten.

This is a warning for all of us.

Many people are standing where they are today because someone invested in them.

A parent prayed.

A pastor taught.

A friend encouraged.

A mentor sacrificed.

But success can create spiritual amnesia. When people reach a position of influence, they can forget those who helped them rise.

We must remember that no one grows alone.

A grateful believer honours the people God has used in his or her journey.

### 3. FORGOTTEN FAITHFULNESS: NABAL AND DAVID! 1 Samuel 25!

Nabal was a wealthy man who owned thousands of sheep and goats. He had prosperity, resources, and security.

But behind his success was an unseen blessing: protection.

During the time when David and his men were in the wilderness, they protected Nabal's shepherds and flocks. They were like a wall of safety around his possessions. They did not take advantage of Nabal or steal from him.

When the time came for the sheep-shearing festival, David sent his servants to kindly request provisions.

Instead of showing gratitude, Nabal responded with arrogance. He questioned David's identity and dismissed the service David and his men had rendered.

Nabal enjoyed the protection but forgot the protector.

He benefited from David's faithfulness but refused to acknowledge it. This is a common human tendency. We often notice what people fail to do while overlooking what they have already done. We become familiar with someone's kindness and begin to expect it. What once amazed us becomes normal.

Families can experience this.

Churches can experience this.

Friendships can experience this.

- ❖ A husband may forget the sacrifices of his wife, and a wife may forget the sacrifices of her husband.
- ❖ Children may forget the sacrifices of their parents.
- ❖ Believers may forget the prayers and encouragement of those who stood with them.

Gratitude requires intentional remembrance.

May God help us remember those who helped us become who we are and reach where we are today.

### 4. FORGOTTEN FREEDOM: GIDEON AND ISRAEL! Judges 8!

Gideon's story began with fear. He was hiding when God



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called him. He saw himself as weak and insignificant, but God saw him as a mighty warrior.

**When the angel of the LORD appeared to Gideon, he said, 'The LORD is with you, mighty warrior.' - Judges 6:12**

Through Gideon's obedience, God delivered Israel from the Midianites. With only 300 men, Gideon experienced one of the greatest victories recorded in the Bible.

The nation enjoyed peace because God worked through Gideon.

But after Gideon's death, Israel quickly forgot.

**The Bible says:**

**The Israelites did not remember the LORD their God, who had rescued them from the hands of all their enemies ... - Judges 8:34.**

They also failed to show kindness to Gideon's family.

The people remembered the victory but forgot the deliverance God had given them through Gideon.

This is a danger for all of us.

We can celebrate the outcome while forgetting the journey. We can enjoy answered prayers while forgetting the One who answered them.

Israel's greatest problem was not that they lacked blessings.

Their problem was that they forgot the Source of those blessings.

Every blessing should lead us closer to God, not further away from Him.

Unfortunately, this is one of the great challenges of the present world. We ask God for blessings, but sometimes the very blessings we receive begin to draw us away from Him rather than bring us closer to Him.

### **5. FORGOTTEN HEALER: THE TEN LEPROS AND OUR LORD AND SAVIOUR JESUS CHRIST! Luke 17!**

Perhaps one of the most powerful pictures of forgetfulness is found in the story of the ten lepers.

Leprosy was a devastating disease. Those who suffered from it were separated from society, unable to live normal lives, and often treated as outcasts.

**Ten lepers saw Jesus and cried out:**

... "Jesus, Master, have mercy on us!" - Luke 17:13.

Jesus Christ showed compassion and healed them all.

- ❖ Ten lives were transformed.
- ❖ Ten people received a second chance.
- ❖ Ten people experienced the power of God.

❖ But only one returned.

**Jesus Christ asked:**

... "Were there not ten cleansed? But where are the nine?"

- Luke 17:17.

The nine received the miracle but forgot the Miracle Worker.

They received healing but failed to return with thanksgiving and worship. Their greatest loss was not physical—it was spiritual. They missed the opportunity to recognise and honour Jesus Christ for what He had done.

How often do we do the same?

We cry out when we need help. We seek God when we face difficulties. We pray for provision, healing, direction, and breakthrough.

But when the answer comes, do we return with thanksgiving?

God does not need our gratitude; but we need gratitude, because it keeps our hearts connected to Him and reminds us of the Source of every blessing.

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# PIT TO PALACE

(Life experiences of Pastor S. Sam Selva Raj)

*"Whoever reads, let him understand" (Matthew 24:15)*

## History of our ST. PAUL'S MATRICULATION SCHOOL!

*...He has dispersed abroad, He has given to the poor; His righteousness endures forever.*

*Now may He who supplies seed to the sower, and bread for food, supply and multiply the seed you have sown and increase the fruits of your righteousness. - 2 Corinthians 9:9, 10.*

Nearly twenty eight years ago, I saw many poor children wandering aimlessly in the village where our **St. Paul's Matriculation School** now stands. Most of these children were unable to attend school because of extreme poverty.

During that period, we conducted **BIBLECOR – Short-Term Bible Correspondence Certificate Course** group Bible studies using the lessons from our Bible Correspondence Course, **New Life for You**, in both English and Tamil. Each group consisted of nearly one hundred underprivileged children, and there were many such groups in different places. To encourage their attendance, we provided them with refreshments. Gradually, the children began learning

simple English words and Christian songs. As they sang these songs at home, they brought great joy to their parents.

At that time, the Lord placed a burden on my heart to establish an English-medium school in that village for these poor children.

*For it is God who works in you both to will and to do for His good pleasure. - Philippians 2:13.*

The Lord confirmed this vision through one of my dear friends, Mr. Sam Daniel, and thus **St. Paul's Matriculation School** was established.

The early years were filled with many challenges. I had to face enormous financial difficulties almost single-handedly. Although many parents eagerly enrolled their children in our school,

meeting the monthly salaries of the teaching staff became a constant struggle.

However, whenever I saw the smiling faces of those poor children greeting me in English and joyfully singing English hymns, I found renewed strength and determination to continue the ministry despite every hardship.

My wife and I reduced our personal expenses as much as possible so that we could sponsor the education of needy children through our educational assistance programme. While two generous brothers helped with the construction of the school buildings, no one came forward to support the day-to-day running of the school. Consequently, on many occasions, we were compelled to sell our personal belongings and even our jewellery to pay the salaries of the teachers and staff.



A few years ago, I had the opportunity to visit a friend who had been admitted to the hospital. However, I arrived outside the designated visiting hours, so I walked through the hospital rather hesitantly.

As I was making my way through the corridor, several doctors, along with the chief doctor, approached from the opposite direction. Without realizing it, I found myself standing directly in their path near the Intensive Care Unit (ICU). Feeling embarrassed and out of place, I quickly stepped aside into a corner and said, "I'm sorry"

To my great surprise, one of the doctors hurried towards me, knelt before me, held my feet, and began to weep.

He said,

"Sir, I come from an uneducated and impoverished family. I struggled greatly in my

studies. Yet you admitted me to **St. Paul's Matriculation School**. You provided me with free



education, uniforms, meals, and every assistance I needed. I did not pay any school fees, but because of your kindness I was able to complete my schooling. Later, I pursued medical studies and today, by God's grace, I am a medical doctor. The spiritual foundation I received during my school days continues to guide my life, and I now share the Gospel with my fellow doctors."

Everyone present was deeply moved. We stood in amazement, witnessing the wonderful work God had accomplished in that young man's life. The doctors treated me with great respect, but all the glory belonged to God alone.

There are many more testimonies like this from our school. It has been only through unwavering faith in the Lord Almighty that we have been able to continue this ministry.

Today, more than 500 students are studying at **St. Paul's Matriculation School**. Among all the schools in the locality, our school was selected to receive the Best School Award, which was presented by the former Education Minister in the presence of the former Minister for Food on 24<sup>th</sup> December 2008.

Our prayer is that God will continue to transform many more lives through this ministry, taking children from the depths of poverty and despair to lives of hope, purpose, and blessing.

*'For I was hungry and you gave Me food; I was thirsty and you gave Me drink; I was a stranger and you took Me in; I was naked and you clothed Me...'*

*Then the righteous will answer Him, saying, 'Lord, when did we see You hungry and feed You, or thirsty and give You drink? When did we see You a stranger and take You in, or naked and clothe You?'*

*And the King will answer and say to them, 'Assuredly, I say to you, inasmuch as you did it to one of the least of these My brethren, you did it to Me.' - Matthew 25:35-40*

Remember the teacher who encouraged you!

And above all, remember our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ - the One who gave His life for us while we were yet sinners; the One who loved us unconditionally; the One who died and rose again for you and me; and the One who is coming again to take us to live eternally with Him.

The greatest danger is not simply forgetting people.

The greatest danger is forgetting God.

May our lives always be marked by grateful hearts that recognise every good gift and every faithful hand that God has used along the way.

Let us never forget the One from whom every blessing flows.
