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for the entire three and half years, till the end of the famine (I Kings 17:16-18). Though our income may be little, God expects a portion to bless us more. For the blessing of God's children, He expects them to bring a minimum of one - tenth of their income to the Church where they have fellowship. **“Bring all the tithes into the storehouse, that there may be food in My house, and prove Me now in this, says the Lord of hosts, if I will not open for you the windows of heaven and pour out for you such blessing that there will not be room enough to receive it”** (Malachi 3:10).

Being oppressed from every side, your life may seem to be a serious battle field; perhaps you are awaiting a deliverance. Take courage, God is on your side. God will not work if you are confused with your identity. What should we do?

1. We have to keep our positions

As children of God, though we are in this world, but not of this world. Our citizenship is in heaven (Philippians 3:20). God raised us up together with Christ, and made us sit together in heavenly places in Him (Ephesians 2:6). Sometimes we forget our lofty positions we have in Jesus and act lowly.

Let us take for example: The office of a ruler is set-up at the head-quarters, from where he functions. He may not be always there, as he travels to many countries. He may visit another country; yet his citizenship and office do not change. He is what he is and belongs to his own country. Similarly, the children of God may belong to any country in the world; but they belong to heaven only. They are not of this world. We are strangers and sojourners in this world and are permitted to live for a while. Our

days are like a shadow in this world (1 Chronicle 29:15). The Psalmist says, in this world I am a stranger (Psalm 119:19); **Your statutes have been my songs in the house of my pilgrimage** (Psalm 119:54); Apostle Peter says, we are the elect pilgrims (1 Peter 1:1,2).

We have been called to live in this world duly embedding the above truth in our mind. Also, we have been asked to store our treasures in heaven (Matthew 6:19, 20). We may live in any country of this world, speak any language, but must always keep in mind that, we belong to the Kingdom of God. However, we have to adopt the culture and habits of the country in which we may live. Let us praise God for everything and live in devotion to one another. The Bible explains it as follows: **“Giving thanks always for all things to God the Father in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ, submitting to one another in the fear of God. Wives, submit to your own husbands, as to the Lord”** (Ephesians 5:20-22). Husbands, love your wives (Ephesians 5:25-28).

In all areas of our lives, it should be written as holy to the Lord (1 Peter 1:15). **“In that day Holiness to the Lord shall be engraved on the bells of the horses ...”** (Zechariah 14:20). “Israel was holiness to the Lord, the first fruits of His increase” (Jeremiah 2:3). **“These are the ones who were not defiled with women, for they are virgins. These are the ones who follow the Lamb wherever He goes. These were redeemed from among men, being firstfruits to God and to the Lamb”** (Revelation 14:4).

Our heavenly citizenship should be reflected in all our conduct. We have to maintain it with all guards. Sometimes we may ask, why should I not commit mistakes as others do? How could I live in this world, if I do not do as others do? In such situations, we must have the resolution that even

if others do, should I not do? My Pastor Rev. Sundaram used to say, “Others may do, but I should not and will not”.

So, in all situations, we should live a unique and separated life. Some Christians say that there is no relation between their spiritual life and secular jobs and professions. Their happiness, love and truth, which could be found in them in the church could not be found in their work spot and in their profession. Some work for the Lord while doing business. They seldom adhere truth in the business. Those who work carry out their business like others, most of whom are unfaithful. They cheat others, use their business tactics and techniques even in the Lord's ministry and even to their Pastors who feed them. When they are counselled, they used to say: “ministry and business are different”. This concept is totally wrong. Children of God should keep their holiness in all areas of their lives as that of a true servant of God. **“We give no offense in anything, that our ministry may not be blamed”** (2 Corinthians 6:3).

(a) An Experience:

Once I approached a well-known servant of God, who is doing the Lord's work and doing the business (buying and selling) of the musical instrument, Accordion, to procure one for me. Displaying one particular instrument, he told me that the instrument was manufactured by the best company in the world. I paid the due price and procured one. Unfortunately, I was in dire need of money for the ministry within a week. So, I took the newly purchased Accordion and told him of my position and my proposal for sale. Immediately, he told me, “Who would buy this? the manufactures are now not in the market. They closed their factory years ago. This is a bad instrument. This is not a saleable commodity”.

And he asked me to take- back home. Beloved children of God, we should not be like this. We should not slip from the position of children of God. Christians who work in various professions should be very cautious and uphold their positions in all things, at all times.

Believers should not mingle with worldly people and indulge in drinking, dancing, receiving grafts, selling addictive, indulging in business malpractices etc.

(b) Another Experience:

Once I took one of my friends to a famous doctor. We both entered into his chamber. Large number of medical equipments were kept inside. But the chair in the chamber was empty. When we went inside, we could find some people chatting and laughing. We wished a person there and began to explain my friend's problems, thinking that he was the doctor, whom we wanted to meet. Soon he pointed another person to meet. Our respect had gone to a wrong person! The position which the Lord gave us graciously should be kept with all reverence. We should not belittle it. **"Therefore, brethren, be even more diligent to make your calling and election sure, for if you do these things you will never stumble; for so an entrance will be supplied to you abundantly into the everlasting kingdom of our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ"** (II Peter 1:10,11).

Children of God have to respect their positions at all times which the Lord has given us. Believers have to be very careful to fulfill their responsibilities and so the servants of God. God's children are the exalted ones in this world. Though they live in this world, their aspiring destination is the Kingdom of God.

2. Garment of Salvation

"I will greatly rejoice in the LORD, my soul shall be joyful in my God; for He has clothed me with the garments of salvation. He has covered me with the robe of righteousness, as a bridegroom decks himself with ornaments, and as a bride adorns herself with her jewels" (Isaiah 61:10).

Dress makes a man. In a hospital, doctors and para-medical staff are given different kinds of dress according to the duty they perform. It is so for a watchmen, sanitary workers, nurses and doctors. Their dress tell of their duty.

Similarly, people who are washed by the blood of Jesus Christ are given a garment (dress) of Salvation. **"that you put off, concerning your former conduct, the old man which grows corrupt according to the deceitful lusts, and be renewed in the spirit of your mind, and that you put on the new man which was created**

according to God, in righteousness and true holiness" (Ephesians 4:22-24).

Some people may not be known to us, but if they are the saved one, we can perceive the divine nature in them and the joy of salvation. Not only in our churches but also in our working places, market places and in other places, if others could identify us as the children of God, the blessing of the Lord will be with us.

In these days even spiritual people are reluctant to use words like Lord, God, Salvation, Prayer etc. in the midst of others. Some feel it is below their dignity to carry the Holy Bible in their hands while going to the church. People of these days are unaware of the fact that, "hands that carry the Holy Bible and knees that bend before the Lord in prayer never fail in life".

Once I went to a hotel along with my family. Before starting to eat, we made a prayer praising the Lord for giving the good day and for the food. When we finished the

prayer, we could see some Christians sitting at the nearby table laughed at us sarcastically. Their look and acts seemed to be telling: "even now, people of this nature are there". Let us leave it.

In all places and in all circumstances, as children of God we must learn to cultivate these traits good. Those who look at us must see to themselves that we are the saved. From our culture and habits one should ask us, "Are you a Christian? Are you a saved man/women? To that extent, our appearance and dress should be maintained. Our face should reflect our heart.

Once I went to Canada on a mission trip. One matured man of God asked me to minister in his church. He was very kind. I was able to see the image of God in him. In the evening he took me to a place and taught me, how a man of God's dress and other manners should be. Preachers who rebuke people that one should not take drinks and indulge in petty pleasures are expected to be away from it. But some while taking the flight and living abroad live as they like! This is something miserable.

Vehicles pass fast on roads. Though the vehicles run fast and whatever may be the volume of traffic, when a traffic police show the "STOP" signal, all vehicles come to a halt. Here we can perceive a vast difference between the display of "STOP" signal by a traffic police in uniform and one in without uniform. The uniform which he sports, confirms his authority. In our spiritual life, our experience of salvation gives us authority, and protection from all evil.

Psalm 18:35 tells like this: **"You have also given me the shield of Your salvation; your right hand has held me up, Your**

gentleness has made me great". See, if we have to live in peace, we have to hold the shield of the Lord's salvation. It will act as a shield to protect us from all evil and calamities. So, in all situations, salvation protects us as a shield.

When we are confronted with the devil and the people of the world, the garment (shield) of salvation protects us. A friend of mine, who is in the ministry, told me a true story. A man was in the grip of evil spirits and was put into untold suffering. He could not eat food. He attacked people who happened to pass him. The family brought the sick man to my friend to pray for.

When the servant of God began to pray, the evil spirit in the sick man said: "This man has been worshipping the living God, Jesus Christ. But he participated in the sacrifices given to the spirits in this village recently. So, I have come and stayed with him. I could not harm him more because his parents christened him, Immanuel. As he

has been bearing this name, I could not destroy him". See, how Satan is powerless even before the very name of Immanuel?

So, when we christen our children, we should be very careful. Some parents without giving much thought, christen their children with names even difficult to pronounce. Christen your children with Bible names and rejoice. You can also name them after the names of spiritual leaders and missionaries and enable them to lead a victorious life. Such things will give them long life and good goal in life. **"Behold, I am coming as a thief. Blessed is he who watches, and keeps his garments, lest he walk naked and they see his shame"** (Revelation 16:15).

3. Separated life is the Victorious one

"Therefore be followers of God as dear children. And walk in love, as Christ also has loved us and given Himself for us, an offering and a sacrifice to God for

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a sweet-smelling aroma. But fornication and all uncleanness or covetousness, let it not even be named among you as is fitting for saints; neither filthiness, nor foolish talking, nor coarse jesting, which are not fitting, but rather giving of thanks. For this you know, that no fornicator, unclean person, nor covetous man, who is an idolater, has any inheritance in the kingdom of Christ and God" (Ephesians 5:1-5).

Some people live in this world with the dictum, that they can live and speak as they like. But God wants His people not to conform to this world. The world may say, live abreast with the world. But it is the will of God that we should live a separated life. But some Christians under the guise of separated life, do not even join with other Christians and claim that they are the separated one and know the scriptures better than others. This is wrong, the separated life taught by the scriptures is something different. There is no wrong in Christians to get together. We have to understand this in the right sense and adhere the following to attain separated life.

(a) To follow God

Now - a - days many Christians involve in politics. If they maintain truth there also, the name of God will not be defiled. They may take it as a way of serving the people. But it should not be their first love in life. Jesus should be first in their lives. But even some Pastors jump into politics and waste their time and talents. The time and money which ought to have spent for their churches and families should not be spent for politics. The Pastors who are called to the ministry of God, should not meddle in politics.

(b) Do not entangle in worldly matters

"You therefore, my son, be strong in the grace that is in

Christ Jesus. You therefore must endure hardship as a good soldier of Jesus Christ. No one engaged in warfare entangles him-self with the affairs of this life, that he may please him who enlisted him as a soldier. And also if anyone competes in athletics, he is not crowned unless he competes according to the rules" (II Timothy 2: 1,3-5). One who is called to the ministry may work relating to support his family. However he should not entangle himself in politics, associations, trades, clubs, etc. Here the word "entangle" is highly important because, **"No servant can serve two masters; for either he will hate the one and love the other, or else he will be loyal to the one and despise the other. You cannot serve God and mammon"**

(Luke 16:13).

(c) Walk in love

"And walk in love, as Christ also has loved us and given Himself for us, an offering and a sacrifice to God for a sweet-smelling aroma" (Ephesians 5:2). 1 Corinthians Chapter 13, speaks of perfect love. **"Love suffers long and is kind; love does not envy; love does not parade itself, is not puffed up; does not behave rudely, does not seek its own, is not provoked, thinks no evil; does not rejoice in iniquity, but rejoices in the truth; bears all things, believes all things, hopes all things, endures all things"** (1 Corinthians 13: 4-7).

The influence of the Holy spirit began to transform my inner being and thoughts from the Age of 16-18 years of my teenage which directed me to sharpen my skills by learning type-writing, short hand and English; and all these have become so useful in my present ministry. I also had an opportunity to know in

I didn't expect him to visit our house at that time. I had seen him only once at his office. Being scared to see him and I hid behind my mother. Pastor was looking lovingly and seriously at me and my room. Finally he was looking at both me and my mother, he said, “God is calling this boy for His service. This boy Sam Selva Raj must come to my office tomorrow morning at 9 a.m.” He then prayed and left my house.

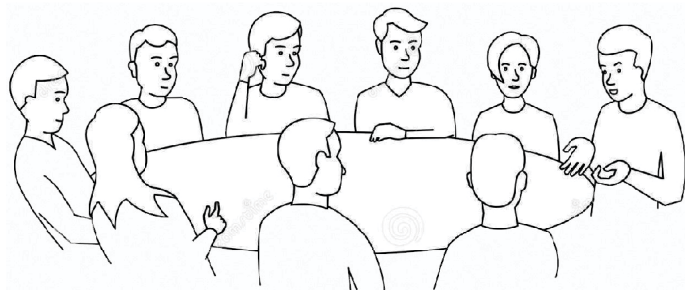

(d) The righteous should not be associated with

Fornication and uncleanness of the like, lust for money etc. should not be talked of against holy people. And even of such names should not be associated with them. Similarly, wanton talks, unsound conversations, mockery etc. are to be avoided. Praising the Lord is the right thing. **“But fornication and all uncleanness or covetousness, let it not even be named among you as is fitting for saints; neither filthiness, nor foolish talking, nor coarse jesting, which are not fitting, but rather giving of thanks”** (Ephesians 5:3,4).

(e) People who have no part in Jesus

Those who indulge in adultery, uncleanness and idolaters of money will not enter into the kingdom of God. **“neither filthiness, nor foolish talking, nor coarse jesting, which are not fitting, but rather giving of thanks. For this you know, that no fornicator, unclean person, nor covetous man, who is an idolater, has any inheritance in**

the kingdom of Christ and God” (Ephesians 5:4,5). Divine poet, Thiruvalluvar has said: *“No clean shave or long hair; if abolish, the one which the world abhors”*. Do not misrepresent by clean shave and sporting long beard. It is always good not to indulge in things which are forbidden. **“These people draw near to Me with their mouth, and honor Me with their lips, but their heart is far from Me. And in vain they worship Me, teaching as doctrines the commandments of men”** (Matthew 15:8,9).

(f) Living sacrifice

Apostle Paul exhorts us to present our bodies a living sacrifice, holy, acceptable to God, which is a reasonable service. **“And do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind, that you may prove what is that good and acceptable and perfect will of God”** (Romans 12:2). So we must stop conforming and start transforming.

These uttermost experiences may seem to be hard, but those who have come into these experiences can hear the still voice
